Edelman Leather Floor and Wall Tiles *Suggested Maintenance and Cleaning* (August 2008)

Maintenance: As Needed

Dust with a soft broom (Swiffer) as necessary. If something spills, simply blot with a soft, very lightly dampened, cloth. Do not rub.

Floor Tile Cleaning : 1-2 times annually, depending on usage

- 1* Do NOT wear shoes during this process.
- 2* Sweep entire floor with soft broom (*Swiffer*).
- 3* Using a professional floor buffing machine, buff entire floor with ONLY *horsehair, or natural fiber buffing brush*. The machine will come with either horsehair or synthetic buffer. Use ONLY *horsehair*.

This step helps to even out the wax.
- 4* Sweep entire floor with soft broom (*Swiffer*).
- 5* Begin waxing (*Butcher's Wax-Amber Polish*) floor in small sections, approximately 4-5 square feet by hand with a cotton cloth. As you wax a section, buff it with the horsehair buffer. Then continue to next section. Wax and buff. Repeat until floor is completed.
- 6* Using a 3M, 4100 *White Super Polish buffing pad*, buff the entire floor.
- 7* Flip the 3M buffing pad and go over entire floor a second time.

 (It is optional at this time to put a terry cloth towel under buffer and go over the area one more time for added shine. This step is primarily for after initial installation.)
- 8* Wait 24 hours before walking on the floor. Wax is wet.

Wall Tile Cleaning and Maintenance: depending on location

Cleaning is a simple dusting, as one would dust any other wall.

Waxing should only be necessary about once annually, depending upon location.

1* Apply wax (*Butcher's Wax-Amber Polish*) by hand using a terry or cotton cloth, in sections no more than 4' x 4'.

2* Using a hand-held buffer (i.e. car buffer), and a terry cloth bonnet, buff each section after it is waxed, one by one.

3* Repeat steps 1 and 2...only for initial waxing, not maintenance.

4* Change bonnet to lambs wool and buff entire wall again.
